In the interest of creating a safe and enjoyable event and to meet Liquor Licensing requirements, the Melbourne Racing Club in conjunction with Victoria Police operates a "Minors Policy" for the Caulfield Spring Racing Carnival.

Any patron under the age of 18 wanting to attend the Caulfield Spring Racing Carnival must be accompanied by a responsible adult or guardian.

A responsible adult, for the purpose of supervising a minor on licensed premises must be a parent or someone reasonably taking the place of a parent.

Age (guiding principle is 30+), relationship and amount of supervision being provided will all be considered in determining whether or not the accompanying adult is responsible:

Presenting as a Responsible Adult includes:

- o being able to maintain effective supervision at all times whilst on course (guiding principle is "in view and able to make contact");
- o not supplying alcohol to minors;
- o behaving in a responsible manner throughout the event;
- o taking responsibility for any untoward actions of accompanying minor;
- o Will not breach the Club's Conditions of Entry; and
- o Understands the Club's right to eject both the responsible adult or guardian and the minor from the course if these requirements are not met.

In addition to meeting the above criteria all Minors must collect a Minors Wristband in the presence of their guardian where both parties can expect to present identification.

Minors found not to be in the reasonable control of their responsible adult or guardian once inside the racecourse will be taken to a Minors Holding Area and have their parent or guardian contact.
